

Field pack — English

A short, offline checklist for safer information use and responsible documentation. This is general preparation information, not legal or medical advice.

01 · Before leaving

- Tell a trusted person your plan and expected check-in time.
- Carry essential medication, water, a charged power bank, and emergency details on paper.
- Consider the privacy risks of unlock methods, cloud backups, and location sharing.

02 · Verify before sharing

- Check the event time, publication time, expiry time, and source tier.
- Do not treat a forwarded message, viral post, or anonymous report as verified on its own.
- Look for a visible correction or retraction record.

03 · Document responsibly

- Preserve the original separately and work only on a redacted public copy.
- Do not publish faces, number plates, medical details, or names without review and consent.
- Record a broad zone only; never publish live positions of protesters, police, medics, or shelters.

04 · If conditions change

- Prioritise personal safety and follow locally verified emergency guidance.
- Do not use this site to coordinate crowd movement or report exact positions.
- Reconnect when safe and confirm that cached information is still current.

Offline material can become stale. Check publication and expiry times before relying on it.
